

# Complete online Health Declaration Form to get QR code before arrival- AASL

The Airport and Aviation Services (Sri Lanka) (Private) Limited (AASL) requests passengers to complete their online 'Health Declaration Form' before landing in order to ease their health check at the airport.

They said both foreign and local passengers who wish to visit the country should fill out the form to obtain the QR code.

The Online COVID-19 Health Declaration System has been introduced at the Bandaranaike International Airport (BIA) with the initial step of moving to touch-free and paperless boarding technology.

The new system was introduced to ease the passenger handling process at the airport. Upon submission, passengers will have the facility to capture a QR code and will also receive an email with that QR code.

With the QR code, airport management would be able to instantly confirm the passenger's health status during their health declaration. The Health Declaration Form was issued by the Health Ministry for easy identification of the COVID status of the arriving passengers.

Passengers can submit their details before boarding the flight, while travelling (provided the flight has internet facility), or after landing at the airport by accessing the AASL official website: [https://www.airport.lk/health\\_declaration/index](https://www.airport.lk/health_declaration/index)

The AASL requests the passengers to fill out the form accurately and completely in English language.
